Sowing the Seed of Success

Ummah Children Academy

For bringing hope and support through impactful humanitarian project for orphaned children, Ummah Welfare Trust (Pak) initiated a unique educational intervention in form of Ummah Children Academy, a state-of-the-art educational facility located at main G.T road, Soria Khel, Nowshera which can cater educational needs of more than **1,000 orphans**. Alhamdulillah

Over the years, this educational intervention is positively increasing the literacy rate, improving



education facilities, and creating generations capable of participating in the development of their families, communities and their country on long-term basis.

Currently, **621 orphaned children** from across Pakistan have access to free-of-cost quality education (Modern | Islamic), boarding, food, medical-care and recreational services under the supervision of highly qualified staff.



Ummah Center for the Disabled

Around 1.3 billion people experience significant disabilities making it 16 percent of the world's population, or 1 in 6 of us where they find it 15 times more difficult to access education and other services as compared to those without disabilities.

To bring back the children with disabilities from



disadvantaged backgrounds into the life cycle, **Ummah Center for the Disabled, Islamabad** is up and running since 2009 where the disability inclusive intervention is currently allowing **56 children** with special needs (**29 - Boys | 27 - Girls**) from district Rawalpindi and others areas to complete their special education and rehabilitation with a hope for a bright future and an opportunity to pursue their dreams.



Ummah College of Technology

If carefully used, young people are some of the world's best creative, enthusiasts and thinkers where their unlocked energy and ideas can help positively to contribute in the development of their economies and societies.

In a transformative step towards equipping an orphaned child, **Ummah College of Technology** was established in 2015 for allowing the targeted orphaned children to acquire market driven skills as the college is currently offering various technologies courses (Diploma of Associate Engineering) including civil, electrical, mechanical along with short courses as well as one-year diploma in Information Technology to **151 students** inside a single building with highly qualified teaching staff & well-equipped laboratories and workshops.



Helping the Marginalized

Widows Sponsorship

According to UN Women, there are more than **258 million widows** around the world, they have historically been left unseen, unsupported and unaccounted for in our societies where widowhood often forces women out of families and social structures, leaving them particularly vulnerable to isolation, violence and poverty.

For a widow, the loss of a partner who is the family's main breadwinner is particularly devastating within the context of broader societal instability where she has to go through emotional sufferings, financial marginalization and even faces extreme violence.

Thanks to the continuous generosity of our donors.

UWT (Pak) effectively allowed **716 financial vulnerable widows** across 39 districts of Pakistan to pay for their immediate needs as per their priorities in a dignified manner and support their efforts to end their sense of hopelessness.



Orphans Sponsorship

For orphaned children, the loss of a parent is not only devastating emotionally and psychologically, but also often results in severe socioeconomic hardships on long term basis resulting lifelong poverty, inadequate access to quality education, absence of healthcare services and many more.

The charity runs, an individual child Orphan Sponsorship Program to deliver required resources for allowing the most-neglected segment of our society to have access to educational resources to unlocking their full potential.



During 2024, UWT (Pak) responded by disbursing Orphan Sponsorship grants across 43 different districts of Pakistan to **1,750 orphaned children (1,120 - boys & 630 - girls)** in the face of extraordinary human suffering and immense pressure on the country's overwhelmed social services.





Propagating the message of Allah

Hifdh Sponsorship

Through Hifdh Sponsorship project, UWT (Pak) helps ensure Muslims students living in poverty to connect with their faith and memorize the Holy Qur'an and further propagate the message of Allah to more spiritually suffering communities.

The project also provides economic support to the **registered Hifdh Teachers** and their families as well as deliver some much-needed financial relief to the families of Hifdh students alongside addressing spiritual sufferings.



145 Hifdh Teachers (Male - 141 | Female - 04) and **2,900 Hifdh Students** (Boys - 2,809 | Girls- 91) inside 145 sponsored Hifdh classes across 03 regions of Pakistan (Khyber Pakhtunkhwa - 111, Sindh - 19 and Punjab - 15) were reimbursed on quarterly basis, Alhamdulillah.



Teacher Sponsorship

To empower the spiritually suffering young Muslim children across Pakistan, an education in Qur'an can allow them to flourish and grow in their faith and practice Islam, once they are graduated.

This can be done perfectly through qualified and expert Islamic Teachers who can support the learning journey of enrolled Muslim children by providing them opportunities to read and understand the Holy Qur'an with Tajweed and Aqeedah.

UWT (Pak) Teacher Sponsorship project aims to allow children living in **481 poor communities across Pakistan** (Khyber Pakhtunkhwa - 416 | Punjab - 56 | Sindh - 09) to access free Islamic education as qualified **Islamic Teachers (431 - Male | 50 - Female)** providing their teaching services in these classes are reimbursement in form of **monthly salaries (PKR 12,000)** for their efforts in rural and some of the hard-to-reach areas of Pakistan.



Supporting Dawah & Education



Masjid Construction

For any Muslim community a Masjid is more than just a place of worship as presence of a Masjid is vital for preserving the heart of the Islamic community, where faith, education, and support converge.

By building Masjids for the needy communities, we not only provide physical structures but also help build the fabric of community life, offering worship space and continuity in times of extreme spiritual sufferings.

Thanks to the donations from the donors and efforts of UWT(Pak), **28 Masjid (06 - Large | 22 - Small)** has been built in the past year in some of the remote parts of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and Sindh, Pakistan, *Alhamdulillah*.

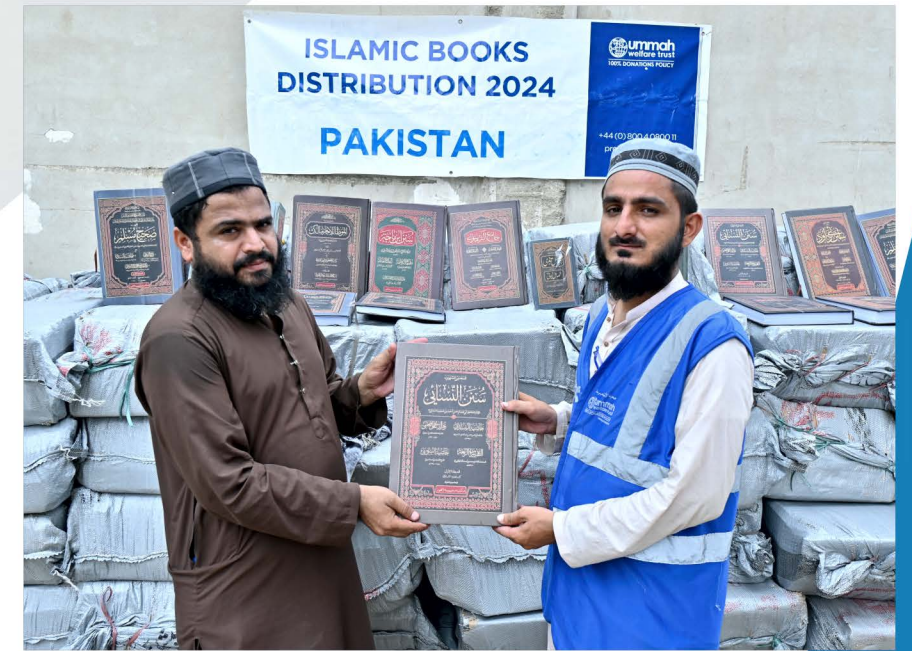


Qur'an & Islamic Books Distribution

Going a step further, the DAWAH interventions of UW T(Pak) also cover provision of **Islamic Textbooks | Copies of the Holy Quran** to the students who are studying in Islamic Schools, but they are likely to lack quality instructional materials in form of books as per the existing syllabus to continue their Islamic education.

Students studying in rural and hard-to-reach parts of Pakistan are provided with Islamic Textbooks | Copies of the Holy Quran for allowing them to learn their daily lessons and prepare themselves for their examination as well.

151 under-resourced Islamic Schools in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Sindh and Baluchistan region of Pakistan were supported through distribution of copies of the **Holy Quran (11,350)** and **469 sets of Islamic Books**.



Food Aid Distribution

In Pakistan, Islamic Schools are not charging any fee from the enrolled students in most cases and those who are charging fees, that are also below average which ultimately force the administrations to rely on local charity and zakat for covering the nutritional and other needs of enrolled students resulting overall marginalization for the students.

Under the Food Aid Distribution Project - 2024, UWT(Pak) under

the supervision of project teams distributed **55,209 Wheat Flour bags (20 kilo each), 11,600 Rice bags (25 kilo each) 63,670 Cooking Oil cartons (05 litre each) and 313 bags of Daal Moong (50 kilo each)**.

Through the annual Food Aid project, resource striped administrations of **452 Islamic Schools | 75,373 students** across **Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (185 schools | 32,984 students), Sindh (184 schools | 31,820), Baluchistan (72 schools | 8,063 students) and Punjab (11 schools | 2,506 students)** region of Pakistan were financially supported, *Alhamdulillah*.

Delivering Timely Relief

Dialysis Centre

Generally, in Pakistan, meeting the healthcare needs of the entire population remains a significant challenge due to the limited access to quality healthcare services and qualified medical staff.

The nation grapple with a myriad of health concerns, ranging from malnutrition to infectious diseases where all these compounded by inadequate medical infrastructure, unavailability of skilled staff and further exacerbated by the shadows of frequent and intense natural disasters.

To improved access to healthcare services for chronic kidney patients in form of dialysis sessions, **02 Dialysis Centers** are operational in district Swabi, KP where these specialist structure in the area are providing treatment services to the needy kidney patients.

Equipped with **12 state-of-the-art dialysis machines** and staffed with 08 employees, both Ummah Dialysis Centers offered **6,568** life-saving dialysis session to registered **73 chronic kidney patients** (41 - Male | 32 - Female), *Alhamdulillah*



Clean Drop of Water

Water Well Construction

In Pakistan, women and children bear the burden of a long water walk on daily basis over hazardous terrain to collect water where this arduous task consumes valuable time that could otherwise be spent on personal growth and advancement.

With a community water well, communities facing water poverty can address their water-related needs which allow them to live healthier lives, send their children to attend school, and entire villages can thrive without the burden of having to travel miles for water collection.

Ummah Welfare Trust (Pak) effectively ended the long water walk for **168 communities** across five district in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa facing water poverty where are the most impactful gifts a donor can give to transform lives of those in dire need of clean water.

In some parts of the country, conventional hand pumps and water wells are inadequate for accessing clean water due to scarcity or deep underground sources.

To address this particular issue, **92 solar-powered** water wells (environmentally friendly) address the water related needs of **92 communities** as solar system with required energy generation were installed under Wash Support project.



Water Well Maintenance

Once a water well is constructed and handed over to the community, a minor breakdown create chronic water shortages resulting water scarcity for those who are relying on that particular water well for their water related needs.

To effectively cope with this situation, UWT (Pak) Wells Maintenance project had allowed **365 communities** (213 - Sindh | 97 - Punjab | 55 - Khyber Pakhtunkhwa) to have an improved access to clean water after the required repair been carried out by the project teams.





Relief For Ramadhan

“Ramadhan is the month in which the Qur'an was revealed a guidance for mankind, and clear proofs of the guidance, and the criterion (between right and wrong)” (2:185)

For hundreds of thousand impoverished families across Pakistan, access to a balanced diet during the blessed days of Ramadhan is nearly an impossible task on regular basis.

Alhamdulillah, every Ramadhan, UWT(Pak) provides thousands of poor families with food packs and cash grants to allow them to fast the month's blessed days with ease and comfort and devote their attention towards worshipping Allah (S.W.T).

Thanks to our donors, the charity spent over **PKR 70.45 million on 2024 Ramadhan Iftar programme** by disbursing Cash Grants to feed the poor Muslims in Pakistan where the disbursement process continued throughout the blessed month of Ramadhan allowing food insecure families to have the required access to nutritionally enriched diet.

Eid Gifts

To bring happiness to the hearts of **1,750 orphaned children**, UWT(Pak) disbursed Eid Gifts (Cash Grants) before Eid-ul-Fitr allowing these orphaned children to complete their Eid preparations as like other children from affluent Muslim families as they have full right to take part in the Eid celebrations.



Sadaqat ul Fitr

Alhamdulillah, in the last segment of the Ramadhan distributions, the charity distributed **2,668 Sadaqatul Fitr Cash Grants** on the Eid day allowing widows, orphans, disabled children and poor families to have much-needed financial support on the occasion of Eid-ul-Fitr to pay for their prioritized needs with dignity and comfort.



Building More Secure Future

New Livelihoods

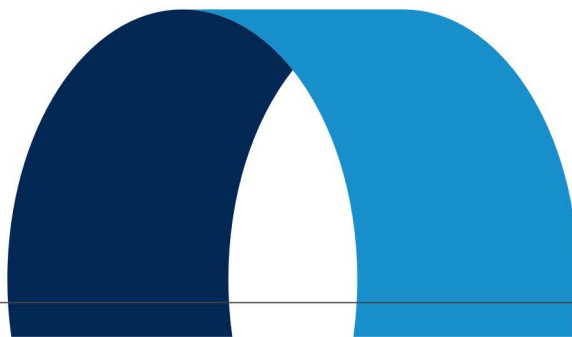
Sustainable Income generation resources provide individuals and communities with the ability to meet their basic needs where these tools, training, and resources can help break the cycle of poverty and create lasting change.

Across Pakistan, millions of people face poverty limited employment opportunities on regular basis where these societal challenges affect families and communities deeply even in most cases forcing many to migrate to other cities in search of a better life.

By investing in sustainable income generation, the charity empowered **44 zakat eligible individuals** (25 - Poor Families | 19 - Islamic Teachers) to thrive, build their futures, and contribute positively to society by having adequate income generation resources in form of Auto Rickshaws.

Vocational Centre

Vocational Training plays a pivotal role for women in the developing world in particular as it serves as a catalyst for socio-economic advancement and empowerment for one of the neglected segments of the society.

Vocational Training equips individuals (women) with required knowledge, cultivates their hidden abilities, and provides further guidance to unexplored avenues to enhance their livelihoods which enable them to make positive contributions to their communities on long term basis.

UWT(Pak) offers **Islamic Education and Vocational Training opportunities** to female students, most of whom are poor and orphaned girls at Islamabad where **100 female students** are coached in crafts such as sewing, embroidery alongside Islamic education, annually.



House Construction

Availability of safe housing with adequate living space and facilities is not only a human right on its own, but also a precondition for the enjoyment of many other fundamental rights, human dignity, and overall well-being.

At UWT (Pak), we firmly believe that every family deserves a place to call home as construction of secure, comfortable houses for shelter-less families and their children, offer a strong foundation for a brighter future.

Alhamdulillah, this year, they charity had built houses with adequate living space having all the required accommodation facilities for the shelter less and economically disadvantaged families across the districts of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa province of Pakistan where the constructed **16 houses (11 - Islamic Teachers | 05 - Widows)** are capable of withstanding natural disasters and other weather-related elements and offer long term stability for the vulnerable families.

Your Qurbani meat reached over **70,799** of our sisters & brothers, Subhan'Allah!



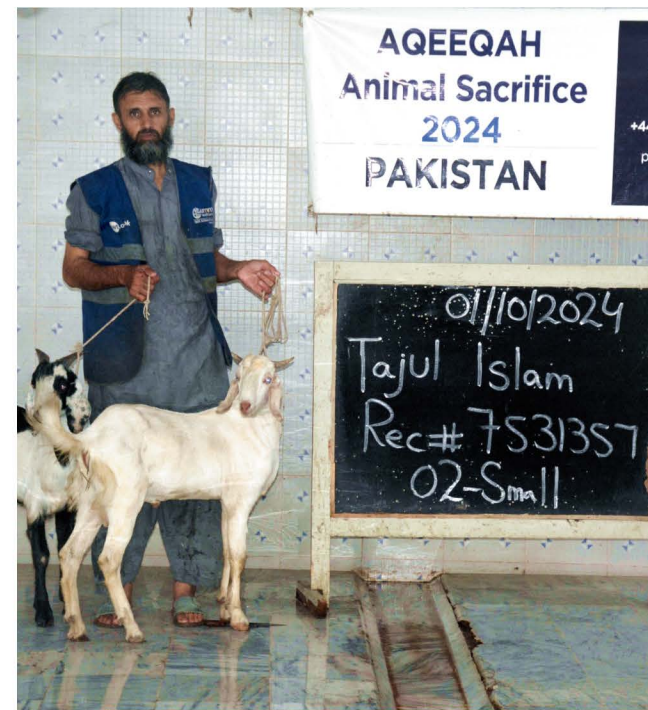
The blessed days of Hajj culminate in the great Sunnah act of Qurbani which is prescribed in the Book of Allah (S.W.T) and the Sunnah of His Messenger (S.A.W) as one of the great deeds of Islam.

Through the incredible generosity of our donors, UWT (Pak) offered sacrifices of **535 - Large Animals (Cows)** and **524 - Small Animals (Goats)** and distributed 66,710 kilos of fresh Qurbani Meat.



This year, the blessings of Eid ul Adha reached the orphaned, widowed, poor, disabled where many recipients hadn't eaten meat all year until your sacrificial animals arrived.

May Allah (S.W.T) accept it from the donors who donated their Qurbani for the brothers & sisters of Pakistan. *Ameen*



Aqeeqah/Animal Sacrifice

Aqeeqah is a Prophetic tradition, a gesture of gratitude for the gift of life, and empathy with the food deprived. **1,203 Aqeeqah sacrifices** (1,185 - Small Animals (Goat) and 18 - Large Animals (Bull) were made on behalf of the donors' newborn babies — Allah protect and light their paths. *Ameen*

Through Aqeeqah, shares of fresh meat reached orphan students of Ummah Children Academy and thousands of students studying in Islamic institutes in Nowshera, Mardan, Swabi, Peshawar, Charsadda where all the beneficiaries sent heartfelt prayers for precious newborns, *Alhamdulillah*.



No More Dependencies

Hardship Assistance

A helping hand in the form of Cash Grants can help families meet their immediate needs effectively as every family has different needs like paying for their healthcare, repaying outstanding debts, covering educational expenses, buying food commodities etc.

Ummah Welfare Trust (Pak) remained engaged by responding with cash-based assistance in form of Hardship Assistance for the people suffering from various diseases and financial marginalization through **498 one-off Cash grants** during separately organized grants disbursement events.



Solar Power Support

Under the Solar Support project, the charity installed **21 Solar Systems** with the different output capacity of **06 KW - 09 systems** | **08 KW - 08 systems** | **12 KW - 04 systems** for increasing access to cleaner, lower cost electricity for the targeted Islamic Schools in Karachi, Sindh. *Alhumdulillah,*

Installation of Solar System is a great idea to use a green energy source that doesn't harm the environment and reduce the electricity cost as well.



Marriage Grants

The inequalities in income and expenditure are widening for poverty ridden families across Pakistan where provision of essential household items to their beloved daughters and sister is a challenging task *on the occasion of their marriage ceremonies.*

Through, Marriage Grant project, UWT (Pak) effectively disbursed **23 one-off Cash Grants (PKR 200,000 - each)** to 20 orphaned and 03 poor girls of marriageable age.

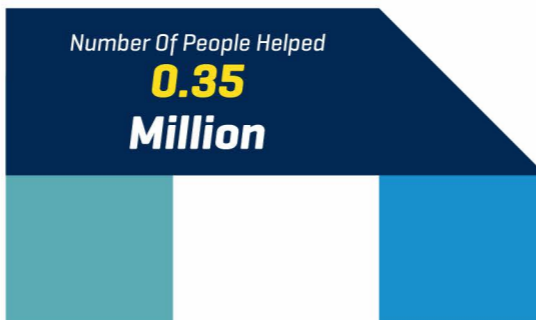
